Show Rules

1. The show is sanctioned by the American Dairy Goat Association and its rules shall govern. There will be a Senior Doe Show (2), a Junior Doe Show (2), a Buck Show (2), a Youth Junior Doe Show, and a Youth Combined Show. There will also be a Best in Show for the open shows. The open shows are sanctioned for the Nigerian Dwarf, Nubian and AOP. The breeds will show in this order but Show order is subject to change. The youth shows are sanctioned for Nigerian only. The open shows are separately sanctioned. The youth shows will consist of a combined doe show and a separately sanctioned junior doe show. The base date for computing the age of the animal entered is March 28, 2026.
2. **DO NOT UNLOAD YOUR GOATS BEFORE CHECK-IN.** There is a CVI requirement to show for any herd traveling from out of state. Any herds exhibiting signs of disease will not be allowed to show. Show committee has the final decision regarding the health of goats. Exhibitors are individually responsible for following all state regulated health certificate requirements. This WILL be enforced.
3. The original registration certificate is required for all animals. A stamped duplicate will be accepted according to ADGA's regulations at the time of the show.
4. Animals with natural horns may not be shown.
5. Check-in will begin at 7:00 AM on Saturday. Goats MUST be on the grounds by 8:00 AM. Judging will begin at 8:30 AM SHARP. Proof of animal's ownership is the name on the registration certificate or stamped duplicate and a CVI are required. The show is rain or shine.
6. Please respect the property and property owner's privacy. Pens are NOT provided. Straw/shavings are not provided. You may show out of your truck/trailer/personal pen(s). **Areas MUST BE CLEANED of all trash before leaving.**
7. Show property owners or affiliates will NOT be responsible for loss, damage, or accident to any person or property. Show entry/attendance indicates acceptance of this.
8. Dogs or any other pets are not permitted on the grounds.
9. Classes are not capped. Entries without payment within 24 hours WILL BE REMOVED.

10. Hand sanitizing stations will be available around the ring for exhibitors to regularly sanitize.
11. Goats should be shown with an appropriate amount of milk in their udders. Over uddered and/or leaking does will be asked to leave the ring at the discretion of the show committee or judge.
12. To ensure the show ends at a reasonable time and runs efficiently, judges will give reasons for the top 5 animals in each class. Exhibitors who would like more information about the placings of their goats may ask questions at the completion of the show.
13. **NO REFUNDS** for scratched goats will be given.
14. Please be ringside and ready to show by the start of your goats' classes. If a goat is not ringside at the start of its class, the show will not wait. Please bring or request appropriate help for multiple goats and/or back to back classes.
15. The show committee reserves the right to make decisions/resolutions not directly addressed in these show rules or in ADGA's rules. The show committee's decision is final, with a unanimous vote.
16. Early entries will be accepted until midnight on the Tuesday before the show. Late entries will be accepted after this date until midnight Thursday before the show. No new entries will be accepted after midnight Thursday before the show. Substitutions can occur until check-in, however must be within the same class.
17. If an exhibitor refuses to abide by show rules, or causes conflict or disruption, they may be asked to leave the show. If an exhibitor is asked to leave the show, they will forfeit all entry and pen fees. Show Committee decision is final.
18. Submitting an entry indicates the exhibitor's acceptance to abide by all rules stated above.
 - Show Fees (must be paid at time of entry)**
 - Fee Per Farm to Enter Show \$15 (one time charge)
 - Open Show Early Entry (ends midnight March 24, 2026)**
\$15 for one ring, \$20 for both rings
 - Open Show Late Entry (March 25, 2026 – March 26, 2026)**
\$30 for one ring, \$40 for both rings
 - Youth Entry (ends midnight March 26, 2026)**
\$15 per entry in Youth Junior Doe Show
\$15 per entry in Youth Combined Doe Show
